The meeting was arranged to consider the way forward following the community councils last meeting where a number of local residents attended expressing concern over the amount of vehicles parking on Fairfax View.

It was agreed in the last meeting that the community council would convene a meeting between all the community partners, Police, Highway Authority and the community council. It was proposed that a meeting was going to be convened on the 17 November at 2.30 pm but a number of attendees were unable to meet due to other diary commitments.

It was agreed that a meeting was to go ahead so a basic strategy could be considered. This would give any meeting with residents an outcome that could be delivered and conforms to the Highway Act.

It was agreed MCC Highways will look at the current situation and the lead officer will contact one of the residents who has been affected with the on street parking and explained how the Highway Authority is going to monitor the situation. If a solution cannot be found a formal consultation will be considered to implement a formal access solution to become lawful
