Re: Site reopened after grenade removed from Caerwent waste disposal site

We are able to confirm that following an incident this afternoon (Friday 27th September) the council's waste disposal site at Caerwent, which is managed by Virador, was closed for a short period.

A member of the public left a bag of garden waste on the site that also contained a training grenade and some ammunition. When this was discovered, site staff ensured that the area was cleared and police were called to deal with the situation. Nobody was hurt and the site was re-opened later in the afternoon.
